The Macaw Clay lick

Along the Tambopata River, only 30 minutes from Cuzco, lies one of the most pristine and unspoiled areas in the Amazon Jungle, the Tambopata Reserve. Housing more species of animals than any other place on earth you will be able to view six-foot river otters, macaws, caiman and many other local flora and fauna. The Reserve has been featured in numerous documentaries highlighting its sustainable tourism practices; the lodge is owned and run by native Indians, and offers remarkable programs deep within the Peruvian Amazon.

Itinerary

Day 1

Puerto Maldonado - Posada Amazonas

Today you will take flight from Lima or Cuzco to Puerto Maldonado. Upon arrival you will be greeted for airport reception and transferred to a motorized boat docked on the Tambopata Port for a 45-minute journey to the Posada Amazonas located in the community's primary forest private reserve. Upon arrival you will be given an orientation of the Posada.

This afternoon enjoy your first activity at the Posada Amazonas, the Canopy Tower. Walking 20-minutes from the lodge you will arrive at the 30-meter scaffolding canopy tower. Following the handrail up the staircase you will reach spectacular views of the expanding forest below with the Tambopata River winding through the middle.

This evening return to the lodge for dinner and to enjoy an evening ecotourism lecture on the ongoing sustainable projects of the lodge.

Day 2

Posada Amazonas

This morning after breakfast you will travel to Tres Chimbadas Oxbow Lake. Traveling by motorized boat for 30-minutes you will disembark for a 45-minute guided trek through the rainforest reaching the lake. Upon arrival you will board a catamaran and cruise the lake in search of the family of nine giant river otters that live in the Oxbow Lake.

After lunch you will transfer by boat 20-minutes downriver to a trail designed by a communal organization producing local medicines and remedies from the forest plants. As you walk along the trail your guide will explain the different medicinal uses of several of the flora found in the rainforest.

After dinner this evening you have the opportunity of enjoying a guided night trek.

Day 3

Posada Amazonas

Early this morning you will visit a parrot clay lick located only a 20-minute walk from Posada Amazonas. Behind a blind only 20-meters away from the clay lick you will view parrots and parakeets, including blue-headed parrots and dusky headed parakeets, descending upon the clay lick to enjoy their morning ritual. Later in the morning enjoy a two hour trek from Posada Amazonas to the giant ceiba tree, the largest tree in the vicinity of the lodge. During your trek the local guides will explain the natural history of the rainforest and its principal taxonomic groups.

After lunch at the lodge, transfer by motorized boat 30-minutes downriver to visit a farm in the Infierno community. Here you will meet the owner who cultivates a diverse variety of popular and unknown Amazon crops for a variety of purposes.

This evening return to the lodge for dinner and to enjoy an evening at your leisure.

Day 4

This morning after an early breakfast you will return to Puerto Maldonado for your flight back to Lima or Cuzco, or to connect with the Yampu add-on of your choice.

Price includes round-trip air transportation from Lima or Cuzco to Puerto Maldonado, lodge accommodation at Posada Amazonas including all meals, all transfers in Puerto Maldonado, guided tours of the Reserve with bilingual naturalist guides and all entrance fees.
