Itinerary

Day 1

Upon arrival in Rio, transfer to your hotel. Afternoon of leisure. Note: Check-in is normally after 2 p.m. Early check-in may be granted, subject to availability (not confirmed).

Day 2

Note: This is a group tour and may involve wait times picking up other passengers at different hotels. We recommend that this tour be done privately in order to avoid this, at an additional cost of \$170 per person, based on two people (\$425 based on one person).

Day 3

Day free to enjoy Rio, or choose from one of our optional day tours.

Tonight, enjoy Rio by night! The night tour includes dinner at a barbecue restaurant followed by a Brazilian music presentation at Rio Scenarium. Rio Scenarium is one of the premier places to listen to the best of Brazilian music. Located in Lapa, where the real carioca spirit of bohemian way of life can be felt. This venue is an antique shop during the day and a live music bar during the night. The programming changes every month. The clients are sophisticated listeners who really enjoy good music. After the show, around midnight, return to the hotel stuffed with tunes.

Day 4

Transfer to airport for flight to Recife. Upon arrival, transfer to the Nannai Beach Resort. Afternoon, free to enjoy the amenities of the hotel.

Price includes international roundtrip airfare from Miami to Rio de Janeiro, hotel accommodation with daily continental breakfast, guided tours in English, meals where specified, entrance fees, transportation between hotels, transfers between airport and hotel, naturalist guides and taxes. Local airport taxes that are payable in the country of destination are not included. Taxes and security fees that can be paid at the time of ticketing are already included in the quote (if airfare has been included in the quote). Prices in Nannai Beach Resort include 4 nights hotel accommodation including breakfast and dinner daily, domestic roundtrip airfare from Rio de Janeiro to Recife, all transfers between airports and lodge with assistance and baggage handling, choice of one tour as listed above, certain amenities at the hotel. Rates not applicable for Carnival, Easter, and December 21 to 31.

This trip includes the Brazil Airpass, which entitles you to 4 segments of air travel within Brazil. Please enquire with your travel consultant about adding extra destinations within Brazil.

Note: U.S. and Canadian citizens require a Visa to enter Brazil which must be requested with plenty of notice.

Hotel Amenities –

The Resort features an extensive 6,000m² set of pools with refreshing, crystal-clear water of various depths, which cover much of the leisure area. Inside the main pool are swimming lanes, exclusive Jacuzzi areas, water volleyball, a beach with a sea view, a children's area and a pool bar.

We offer a five-day package to the Nannai Beach Resort with an option to extend your stay. Four nights hotel accommodations, includes breakfast and dinner (buffet) when served in the hotel restaurant. Beverages not included and round trip transfers are included in the cost.

City Tour Recife and Olinda –

The tour begins with a panorama of Recife, including the three islands (Recife, Santo Antônio and Boa Vista) that make up the city centre, the bridge of Maurício de Nassau, Praça da República (flanked by the Governor's Palace, Santa Isabel Theatre and the Law Courts) and the Casa da Cultura, a fine building dating from the 19th century. Originally a prison, it's now a centre for regional culture, with craft stores and local delicacies.

In Olinda we'll visit Alto da Sé, with the churches of Sé and Misericórdia, and a breathtaking view of the twin cities. In Carnival, joyful revelers parade down the streets after following the traditional giant puppets, like the Homem da Meia-noite ("Midnight Man"), or joining in the town's colourful carnival troupes, such as Pitombeira dos Quatro Cantos and Elefante.

Tamandaré and Carneiros Beaches

One of the locals' favourite beaches for watersports, Carneiros has calm, shallow waters ideal for diving, plus broad sands perfect for playing and sunbathing. The dense coconut groves make Carneiros a fine example of a Northeast Brazilian beach.

Igarassu and Itamaracá Island. One of Brazil's earliest colonial towns, Igarassu is the location of Igreja de Santos Cosme e Damião. Built 1535, it's considered to be the oldest church in Brazil.

An exotic coastal island with 84 square kilometres of nature, history and beauty, Itamaracá is a favourite location for watersports. There's also Forte Orange, built by the Dutch in the 17th century and the Marine Manatee Centre, a research and conservation centre for one of the most precious endangered species still found on the coast of Northeast Brazil. For your pleasure and enjoyment, the tour includes a catamaran trip to Coroa do Avião, a paradisiacal sand bar and observation point for migratory birds.

Maragoggi/Alagoas

A beach that is a true gem of Alagoas State, one of Northeast Brazil's most beautiful. Enjoy a boat trip to explore the galés (a complex of coral reefs and sandbanks 6 km offshore, where you can swim and appreciate the flora) or a buggy trip – all in region of unspoilt white sandy beaches with crystal-clear waters and plenty of shade from coconut trees.

Optional tours

Caruaru and Nova Jerusalem \$231 per person based on two people traveling

Traditional earthenware sculptures, rope and leather craft, the natural beauty of Pernambuco's Agreste highlands and the customs of the local people. A regional market town 130 km inland from Recife, Caruaru has been recognised by UNESCO as the largest centre for figure sculpture in the Americas: the craft market is certainly an unforgettable highlight of the tour. The clay figures, a legacy of the great folk artist Mestre Vitalino, make unique souvenirs to take back from your trip. After Caruaru, we'll visit Nova Jerusalém, the world's largest open-air theatre, where Christ's Passion is performed every year during Easter Week. Lunch will be served at Pousada da Paixão, a lodge inside the theatre (itinerary not available during Easter Week).

João Pessoa and Paraíba \$ 187 per person based on two people traveling

A marvellous opportunity to visit the charming capital of Paraíba State, don't miss this pleasant panoramic tour to the centre of João Pessoa, Solon de Lucena Park, with its famous lake, the beach of Tambaú, Cabo Branco and Ponta do Seixas, the easternmost point in the Americas. João Pessoa is just 115 km north of Recife.
