### Itinerary

#### Day 1

Upon arrival in Rio, transfer to your hotel. Afternoon of leisure. Note: Check-in is normally after 2 p.m. Early check-in may be granted, subject to availability (not confirmed).

## Day 2

Full-day of touring Sugar Loaf, Corcovado Mountain and Tijuca rainforest. Drive along Rio's famous beaches to the Praia Vermelha cable car station, where you will be taken to the Urca Mountain (mid-way station) with its gardens and lookout points. Then, the second part of the ride will take you to the peak of Sugar Loaf Mountain, 1,300 feet above sea level. Continue to the Cosme Velho train station. The cogwheel train will climb up through the Tijuca rainforest and will bring you to the steps of the Christ statue. At 2,300 feet above sea level, it is a breathtaking view of the city of Rio de Janeiro, Guanabara Bay, Sugar Loaf Mountain, the nine-mile Rio-Niterói Bridge, the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon and Atlantic Ocean. Lunch included.

Note: This is a group tour and may involve wait times picking up other passengers at different hotels. We recommend that this tour be done privately in order to avoid this, at an additional cost of \$170 per person, based on two people (\$425 based on one person).

## Day 3

Day free to enjoy Rio, or choose from one of our optional day tours.

Tonight, enjoy Rio by night! The night tour includes dinner at a barbecue restaurant followed by a Brazilian music presentation at Rio Scenarium. Rio Scenarium is one of the premier places to listen to the best of Brazilian music. Located in Lapa, where the real carioca spirit of bohemian way of life can be felt. This venue is an antique shop during the day and a live music bar during the night. The programming changes every month. The clients are sophisticated listeners who really enjoy good music. After the show, around midnight, return to the hotel stuffed with tunes.

Note: Transfers are done via bus and may involve wait times picking up other passengers at different hotels. We can offer private transfers at an additional cost of \$76 per person, based on two people (\$152 based on one person).

## Day 4

Morning, transfer to the airport for flight to Salvador. Charter flight to Kiaroa from Salvador. Enjoy discovering the hotel and beach while you settle into your bungalow. Dine on delicious seafood and take an evening walk along a white sand beach.

## Day 5

Lounge on your private balcony, feeling the warm tropical breeze on your skin. Relax on pristine beaches, wander through an old fishing village, or set sail on one of the resort's private yachts.

## Day 6

Enjoy another day in paradise, feeling your body slowly adapt to the rhythm of life as it should be.

## Day 7

Take a morning swim and savor a fresh tropical juice before preparing for your flight back to Salvador. In Salvador, take flight to Rio de Janeiro for connecting flights back home or overlap with other Yampu programs.

Price includes international roundtrip airfare from Miami to Rio de Janeiro, roundtrip domestic airfare from Rio de Janeiro to Salvador, charter flight from Salvador da Bahia to Kiaroa, hotel accommodation in Rio with daily continental breakfast, guided tours in English, meals where specified, entrance fees, transportation between hotels, transfers between airport and hotel, naturalist guides and taxes. Local airport taxes that are payable in the country of destination are not included. Taxes and security fees that can be paid at the time of ticketing are already included in the quote (if airfare has been included in the quote).

In Kiaroa, prices include breakfast and dinner each day, non-alcoholic drinks at meals and full use of hotel facilities. Our 4-star option is with the Moorea Luxury Bungalow or the Malindi Bungalow.
