Itinerary

Day 1

Monday

Upon arrival in Quito, transfer to your hotel.

Day 2

Tuesday

Full Day Colonial Quito Tour & the Equator The tour begins with a visit to Independence Square, where the Presidential Palace, the Cathedral and El Sagrario Church are located. We will also visit the Church of La Compañía (1605), with its amazing gilt altars. This is considered the finest example of baroque art in America and the Moorish influence can also be noted in the intricate designs carved on the magnificent red-and-gold columns and ceilings. Afterward we will take you to the church and monastery of San Francisco (1535). This is the oldest Ecuadorian church, and the main altar inside is a spectacular example of baroque carving. There is also a fine collection of artwork, including paintings, sculpture and furniture dating back to the 16th century. Finally we will drive up to the highest viewpoint of the city, El Panecillo, where we will have a spectacular view of Quito and the opportunity to see an old church with the famous "winged virgin" of Quito. After visiting the colonial and modern areas of the city, a 30-minute drive will take us to La Mitad del Mundo (the Middle of the World) with its 30-meter-high monument marking the equatorial line and excellent ethnographical museum.

Day 3

Wednesday

Transfer to the airport for your morning flight from Quito or Guayaquil to Baltra airport in Galapagos (approx. 2.5 hour flight). You will be greeted by guides at the airport and transferred to the Coral I or Coral II at the Baltra Port.

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PM: Ballena Bay & Eden Islet, Santa Cruz (a) or Galapaguera de Cerro Colorado, San Cristobal (B).

Day 4

Thursday

AM: Wetlands & Muro de las Lagrimas, Isabela Island (A) or Cerro Brujo, San Cristobal Island (B).

PM: Sierra Negra, Isabela Island (A) or Punta Pitt, San Cristobal Island (B).

Day 5

Friday

Punta Moreno, Isabela (A) or AM: Espumilla Beach and Buccaneer Cove, Santiago Island (B).

PM: Elizabeth Bay, Isabela Island (A) or Puerto Egas (James Bay), Santiago Island (B).

Day 6

Saturday

AM: Tagus Cove, Isabela Island (A) or Bartolome Island (B).

PM: Punta Espinoza, Fernandina Island (A) or Sullivan Bay, Santiago Island (B).

Day 7

Sunday

Today you will return to Baltra for your return flight to Quito. Upon arrival you will be greeted for airport reception and transferred to your hotel.

Day 8

Monday

Transfer to the airport to take the international flight back home.

Price includes:

- International air from Miami to Quito round-trip; domestic air from Quito to the Galapagos round-trip; 4 nights cabin on the Coral I or Coral II; all meals on the cruise; hotel accommodation in Quito including buffet breakfast; daily guided tours of the islands, led by naturalist guides; full-day excursion in Quito; all transfers. Also included in the rates are \$100 Galapagos Park fee and the \$10 Transit Control Card fee are both included in these rates.
- Local airport departure taxes that are payable in the country of destination are not included. Airfare taxes and security fees that can be paid at time of ticketing are included in the cost.
- Please note that cruise itineraries are subject to change without prior notice.
