



## Fernando de Noronha



Coastal View

The archipelago of Fernando de Noronha lies in the Atlantic Ocean, 225 miles off the coast of Brazil. With its crystal-clear water and rich marine life, the archipelago here is a heavenly retreat for underwater pleasures. The main island is sparsely populated and tourism has become the main source of income for locals. The archipelago can be reached either by plane or by boat. Diving is the island's major attraction. Its transparent water has 40m visibility, 230 fish species, 15 coral varieties and five types of shark. Snorkeling is best at Baia dos Porcos, Ponta das Caracas, Baia do Sueste and Atalaia, where there is a large pool at low tide. Scuba divers tend to prefer Ilha Rata, Ilha do Morro de Fora, Enseada da Rasureta and Ponta da Sapata.

Accommodations are Pousadas that are small hotels without traditional star ratings. We have categorized the pousadas in ratings according to our opinion and personal experience.

For beginners, the best season for snorkeling and scuba diving is from July to December. The rainy season in Fernando de Noronha arrives from April to June.

## Itinerary

## Day 1

Upon arrival in Recife, airport reception and transfer to your hotel in Fernando de Noronha. Enjoy the afternoon and evening at leisure to become acquainted with this beautiful location.

## Day 2

This morning we will pick you up at your hotel for a tour of the island in 4x4s. We will travel to various outlooks for impressive views of the archipelago stopping along the way Baia do Sancho to visit the natural swimming pools and Atalaia beach. After the tour we return to your hotel for an afternoon at leisure.

## Day 3

This morning we transfer from the hotel to the waters to snorkel amongst the exotic marine life. The pristine visibility allows you to observe the dolphins and sea turtles close up in their natural habitat. Sites most commonly visited include the shipwreck of Santo Antonio, Morro de Fora, and Sueste Bay. Note: The location is subject to change due to weather conditions and the local environmental authority. After, we return to our hotel for an afternoon of leisure. This evening we suggest enjoying a memorable and romantic dinner at the beach underneath the stars.

## Day 4

Enjoy today at your leisure. We suggest participating in an early morning hike to Dolphin Overlook where we can spot the dolphins returning from the open ocean as the sun rises over the cliffs.

## Day 5

Enjoy the morning at your leisure. This afternoon we return to the airport for our flight back to Recife.

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## Price includes:

Price includes round-trip airfare from Recife to Fernando de Noronha, round-trip ground transfer, four night hotel accommodation and breakfast. Does not include local airport taxes which must be paid locally. Also not included is the obligatory environmental tax paid as a donation to the conservation of the area.

Not Included: entrance fee to the Marine national Park – R\$ 10 per pax / per diving (around U\$ 7) – Bilingual speaking guide assistance during tranfers NOT INCLUDED. For English speaking guide assistance please add additional charge.
