



Chapada Diamantina



For those that enjoy adventure, Chapada Diamantina is 'Paradise on Earth'. Trekking, rappelling, diving, caving and canyoning bring excitement to every excursion. Afterwards, there's a chance to relax in the crystal-clear waters of the many rivers and waterfalls.

But it's not just the nature that's outstanding. Lençóis, the main town in the region, enchants every visitor with its fine colonial buildings, cobbled streets and friendly residents. A historical town, Lençóis' peak was during the gold diamond rush, when it became the third most important town in the state of Bahia.

In the 17th century in Brazil, when there was the gold and diamond rush many people came to Bahia in search of treasures. Some did find gold or diamonds, but the greatest fortune of Chapada cannot be measured in carats – it's the immense natural beauty, which has been protected by law since 1985, with the establishment of Chapada Diamantina National Park.

Itinerary

Day 1

Monday

Depart from Salvador 07:30 am, in microbus with air conditioning, video, color TV, sound, individual and reclining seats, guide and driver. Stop for lunch (included) at Itaberaba City. Arrival planned for 03:00pm. At 06:00pm city tour of Lençóis.

Day 2

Tuesday

In the morning tour on the Rio Lençóis, passing by the Colorful Sand hall and taking a nice bath in the Cachoeirinha. In the afternoon we'll visit Ribeirão do Meio.

Day 3

Wednesday

In Poço do Diabo we will stop and appreciate a beautiful waterfall formed by the Rio Mucugezinho, with option for Tirolesa and Rappelling. View the Morro do Pai Inácio, perhaps the biggest symbol of Chapada Diamantina. Then we'll visit the Gruta Azul and Gruta da Pratinha. Lunch (included), option of Tirolesa and Flotation. Explore 850 meters of extension and impressive rock formations of Gruta da Lapa Doce.

Day 4

Thursday

In the morning, say goodbye to Lençóis and leave for Mucugê, on the way it is possible to see Poço Encantado. Poço Encantado is a main attraction of Chapada. Witness the natural light that allows visibility of the rocks 40 meters under water. In the afternoon we will arrive in Mucugê, passing by the Projeto Sempre Viva, and at night we will have a pleasant stroll through the streets of Mucugê.

Day 5

Friday

Tour to Cachoeira do Buracão, considered one of the most beautiful waterfalls of Chapada. Located at Ibicoara, 115 km of Mucugê, the Waterfall is impressive not only because of the height but also for the magnificent Canyon in front.

Day 6

Saturday

Depart at 7:30 am, arrival at Salvador Praia Hotel around 3:00 pm
