Tuesday: 15:00 Flight to Puerto Williams; 16:30 Overflight of Cabo de Hornos (Cape Horn); 17:30 Transfer to Lakutaia; 18:00 Trekking to summit of Cerro Bandera (breath taking views of the Beagle Channel); 20:00 Return to Lakutaia; 20:30 Group Discussion in the Library-map; 21:00 Dinner and lodging.

## Day 2

Wednesday: 7:30 Breakfast; 8:15 Bus ride to Puerto Navarino via Darwin's Route (visit the sites visited by Charles Darwin); 9:45 Sailing to Wulaia (the historic site of Evangelization of Yamana People); 12:30 Disembark, with observation of ancient dwelling sites, Wollaston/Hoste Archipelago); 14:00 Patagonian barbeque lunch; 15:30 Sail back to Puerto Navarino; 19:00 Return to Lakutaia; 20:00 Group discussion in our Library-map; 21:00 Dinner and lodging.

Thursday: 8:00 Breakfast; 9:00 Stable-sorting of horses/helmets; 10:00 Start of horseback ride; 12:00 Los Bronces Falls; 13:00 Picnic with a panoramic view of the Beagle Channel; 14:30 Start of return on the beach front; 17:00 Arrival at stables; 17:30 Free time for independent discovery; 20:00 Dinner and lodging.
