This trip will also take us to Colonia, founded by the Portuguese and disputed for years by the crowns of Spain and Portugal; it holds the magic of its history intact. Declared Cultural heritage of the Humanity by the UNESCO in 1995, Colonia de Sacramento invites you to a trip through the time. You can find charming stoned paved alleys lightened up by traditional and characteristic yellowish lanterns, on which uncountable historical and cultural attractions are there to discover and enjoy. The street of the Sighs, the Viceroy's House, the Matriz Chapel, the Bullring, the Door of the Ciudadela, are only some of the architectural beauties that this spectacular city hosts.

Our trip ends at San Pedro de Timote, one of the most prestigious and best known historic Estancia of Uruguay. This Estancia, founded in 1854, was before the land of Uruguay's first and most important Jesuit Estancia and thus the very first European agricultural venture. Today you can stay as a guest in any of the 30 rooms of San Pedro, enjoying its charm and the activities that it offers. Make long walks along the 500 hectares of park, horseback ride, or cuddle by the open fire places.

Itinerary

Day 1

Overnight flight to Montevideo.

Day 2

Montevideo

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon we will visit Montevideo's most important attractions and the typical Mercado Del Puerto, where we can get some time to have lunch.

Note: check-in is normally after 2 pm. Early check-in may be granted subject to availability (not confirmed).

Day 3

Montevideo

Day at leisure to enjoy optional excursions. We suggest a full day visit to Punta del Este.

Day 4

Montevideo - Colonia

After breakfast, transfer to the bus station to take the bus to Colonia del Sacramento. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel.

In the afternoon, we will have a city tour visiting Colonia's most important attractions. Colonia is an old city which has been declared World Heritage by the UNESCO. We will visit the little stone streets, old edifications, forts, Spanish and Portuguese Museums, the port, downtown, the Ferrando Beach, the wonderful Coastal Rambla which borders Colonia from the Old City to the "Real de San Carlos" where we will visit the bullring, the horses' race course and the old port. Later, transfer to your hotel.

Day 5

Day at leisure to enjoy optional excursions. We suggest the full day visit to "Los Cerros de San Juan's" vineyard, where you can have lunch and taste the typical Uruguayan wine "Tannat".

Day 6

San Pedro de Timote

After breakfast, transfer to San Pedro de Timote typical estancia. Upon arrival, check in and lunch at the estancia. In the afternoon we will visit the countryside on horseback; we will learn a little more about the Uruguayan Gaucho culture. Dinner and lodging at the estancia.

Day 7

San Pedro de Timote

Today, you will be able to go horseback riding or to participate in the daily rural activities. Lunch at the Estancia. In the afternoon, we will go on a photographic safari. Dinner and lodging at the estancia.

Day 8

Montevideo

After breakfast, transfer to the airport to catch your flight back home or overlap with an add on of your choice.
