After breakfast, we will have a morning city tour of Buenos Aires, visiting the Historic Neighborhood of San Telmo, the art district with its Artisan & antiques fair at Dorrego Square. From there, we will head to Plaza de Mayo (Main Square), and the exclusive Barrio of Recoleta, famous both for its cafés and its fancy elaborated cemetery of the Argentine aristocracy. We will get some time for lunch at the square and the afternoon at leisure. Early evening stop at La Cava del Querandí – Wine Club to sample premium wines of Argentina's different wine regions. Return to the hotel for some time before we go for a Tango evening gala . Try a few steps yourself, and enjoy the art of superb musicians & dancers (Dinner is included). Note: Cava del Querandí is open only on weekdays.

Prices include hotel accommodation including daily continental breakfast, all transfers between airports and hotels with assistance and baggage handling, guided tours in English including entrance fees and meals where specified.

Note: Wine or any other alcoholic beverage are not included during dinner.

No visa is required for travel to Argentina as a U.S., Canadian or Australian citizen. A reciprocity fee must be paid upon entering Argentina. The current amount that must be paid by U.S. citizens is \$140 per person and \$75 per person (single entry) for Canadian citizens.
